SEVERE WEATHER PLAN

It may be that the structure and timetable of the school day will look a little different. For example, it may be necessary to shorten the day by starting later and finishing earlier.

If the school has to close, the Before/After School Club will also be closed.

Other things to note

- Be prepared to send your child in with a packed lunch at short notice as we would like to remain open even if catering staff are unable to make it into school
- Ensure that your child has appropriate warm outdoor clothing and footwear
- Keep your child at home if they cannot come into school safely contact school as is the case with any absence

In the event of bad weather while the school is in session, parents/carers will be informed by text message/email, should it be necessary to pick the children up at an earlier time. It will be useful for parents/carers to have their own back up procedures in place.
