Developmental Language Disorder is a hidden but common disability that affects 1 in 14 people causing difficulties understanding and using language for no known reason. The 2023 DLDday theme is *DLD Around the World*, highlighting that DLD occurs in every language.

Speech and Language UK Report around rising needs in children and young people.

A recent report completed by Speech and Language UK, which was published this week entitled 'Unheard Children' has highlighted that there are now 1.9 million children in the UK who are struggling with talking and understanding words, which is approximately 1 in 5 children in classrooms. This is a 26% increase over the last 2 years and calls for Government action to put Speech and Language therapy at the centre of education plans.

Here within the team at CCICP, we are committed to working with everyone to ensure that we can impact on this figure and provide the support that children and young people need to help achieve their goals.
