Dear Parents/Guardians.

We are planning to take the whole school to the Grange Theatre, Northwich, to see the Goldilocks & the Three Bears pantomime. This will take place on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December. We have booked 3 coaches, fitted with seatbelts and below is the proposed itinerary for the day.

## PLEASE NOTE THAT THE PANTOMIME STARTS AT APPROX 9.30-9.40AM AND CHILDREN WILL NEED TO BE AT SCHOOL EARLY ON THIS DAY TO ALLOW FOR TRAFFIC IN GETTING TO HARTFORD IN NORTHWICH

8.20am Children to arrive at school promptly

8.30am Depart School

9.40am (approx) "Goldilocks & The Three Bears" pantomime at the Grange Theatre, Northwich

11.45am Pantomime finishes – approximately

12 Noon Depart the Grange Theatre - approximately 1.00pm Arrive back at school – dependant on traffic

All children will be having a packed lunch on their return – whether this is a pre-booked packed lunch on the SchoolGrid system or a packed lunch they have brought to school with them

- All children to be in school uniform.
- Children should be collected as normal at the end of the school day.
- Please inform WOSC of any changes in pre-booked sessions with them for this date.

The cost of this visit per child will be £17.97, which includes the cost of the pantomime and the coach fare. Although there is no obligation to contribute this money I am afraid the visit cannot go ahead unless parents are willing to make this voluntary contribution. On application to the Head Teacher, charges may be waived or reduced under certain circumstances.

Please use the SchoolMoney facility to pay and give consent for your child to go on this trip. Please make payment by Friday 10th November. This will enable the school to make the obligatory payment to the Theatre.
