Dear Parents/Guardians,

Last night we finally received more clarity regarding the public health situation in the area and feel that we are now in a position to move forward with our plans to re-open (I have attached the letter from our Director of Education). This means that we will go ahead with the sequence that we had previously arranged, starting on **Monday 15th June with our Reception class, Wednesday 17th June with Year 1 and Monday 22nd June with Year 6.** We will still be providing cover for the children of Key Workers. All the details of the previous phased plan remain the same and I have attached them below:

Please arrive as close to the allotted start and pick up times as possible, using the correct entrance. To remind you:

RECEPTION – STARTING ON MONDAY 15TH JUNE

There are

Group A with Mrs Croft/Miss Holdsworth and Miss Marks, using the year 1 classroom. They should be brought to main wooden gate at the entrance to the reception play area on Common Lane (please do not use any other school gate).

Drop off time: 9.15am Collection: 3pm (except Fridays)

Friday collect :12.15

Group B with Mrs Gordon/Mrs Moulson and Mrs Hughes, using the reception classroom. They should be brought to main wooden gate at the entrance to the reception play area on Common Lane (please do not use any other school gate).

Drop off time: 8.45am Collection: 2.30pm (except for Fridays)

Fridays collect: 11.45am

YEAR 1 – STARTING ON WEDNESDAY 17TH JUNE

Group A with Miss Tandy with Mrs Muir/Mrs Able, using the year 2 classroom. All parents use the village hall car park gate. Please drop off your child at the edge main playground past the end of the climbing wall – markings will be in place.

Drop off time: 9am Collection: 2.45pm (except Friday)

Friday collect: 12 noon

**Group B with Miss Davies with Mrs Stanworth/Mrs Friend, using the year 3 classroom.
All parents use the village hall car park gate. By the marking at the top of the slope coming from Village Hall car park. The children will use rear door of year 3 classroom.**

Drop off time: 9.30am Collection: 3.15pm (except Friday)

Friday collect: 12.30pm

YEAR 6 – STARTING ON MONDAY 22nd JUNE (to be confirmed)

I will update you early next week with the details for year 6, however they will be split into two groups.

KEY WORKER CHILDREN

Should enter via the main car park gates (which will be half open)– not the pedestrian gate which will be reserved for reception parents and drop off/pick up at main hall doors in car park. PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE INTO THE CAR PARK

Drop off time: 9am (unless otherwise indicated)

Collection time:3pm (unless otherwise indicated)

I will add the recovery plan for school to the website. It is in our recovery plan that when a child/member of staff is sent home with symptoms that the bubble can still remain in school until the results of a test of the virus is known. This is in line with government guidance. However due to the fact that Test and Trace is still so early in its implementation, the school may decide, with the support of the Local Authority, to isolate the bubble earlier than the national guidance would indicate prior to the outcome of the test result being known. Other things to remember:

- Social distance at all times
- Don't forget to order your lunches beforehand (including Key Workers' children) on the SchoolGrid website –this includes Friday, despite the early finish
- The children can bring in their own water bottles
- Please only visit the school office for essential purposes such as to leave medication or to pick up a child who is ill
- If you need to contact school either phone or email in the usual way.

If you have changed your minds about sending your child back into school please let us know via email, otherwise you do not need to do anything and we will expect your child as planned. I know you will have worries about things changing again at the last minute, and given what has happened recently I don't blame you at all, but I feel at last we have a bit of clarity. The last thing I want to happen is to let you and your children down again.
