



## Remote Learning Plan

During the Covid-19 pandemic Waverton Primary School may expect some disruption to school routine by individual pupil, class, part school or whole school isolation.

School has considered the DFE guidance for home learning and has a strategy in place to facilitate home learning if and when the need arises.

We will provide live face to face sessions as well as uploading learning tasks.

The expectation is that children attend all live lessons and complete the set learning tasks to the best of their ability. However, we appreciate that circumstance vary and this may not always be achievable. Please inform the office if your child is unable to attend a session. Where there is staff absence, work will be set but live lessons will not be held, parents will be informed should this be the case.

### Safeguarding

Pupils are reminded of the rules with regard to the safe use of technology and the internet and that the school Behaviour Policy (Be ready, Be Safe, Be Respectful) remains in place during distance learning. Staff abide by the Code of Conduct. Staff monitor and report any safeguarding concerns.

### Google Meet Protocol

The purpose of Google Meet calls can include:

- regular face to face contact with the children
- allowing teachers to share learning overviews with the children
- checking in on children's learning and wellbeing
- sharing stories with the children
- answer questions from the children
- lead short teaching sessions with the children
- explain tasks to the children

Please Note: These sessions are for children, not adults/parents. When your child is accepted into the chat by the teacher, there are guidelines we all must follow to keep everyone safe.
